

PHOTO SHOOTING PREPARATION (general)

Cloths:

Simple/plain colors (good is white, light pink, light blue, light green, grey, light yellow)

Jeans are ok too

Try to avoid too many patterns and too strong colors

No short skirt

No shorts for adults

Shoes closed (no flip-flops)

Try to keep one style of dress for each person on a picture (applicable only for group shots)

Style should match with all parts of your outfit (shoes, bag, jewelry, cloths, hair)

Bring a back up outfit especially top part (it is hot in Hong Kong!); it is good to take shots with 2 or 3 different outfits.

Other:

If you have a nice **blanket**, which you do not mind to take outside could be good, too. (Only for outdoor photo-shoots however is not necessary.) For business portraits props demonstrating your job or profession can be useful.

Make up:

As you normally wear but you can use at least 80% stronger. On a picture you will look like wearing only a light make up.

For location shots: Bring comb and make up for retouch.

Preparation:

No strong color lack on nails and make sure your hand are nicely done Go to bed early

Wash your hair night before

Not too much jewelry unless it's your style and you really want to present it.

Since the photo shootings are often outside don't forget about your mosquito protection.
